- Evaluations

- Talked about having an ID camp after the season ends for top teams next year
- Met with Tracey from Strathmore and out combining with Strathmore - should work out well with making teams. We have lots of older girls and they have lots of younger players. Fees need to be gone over. Our fees are much higher than there's. Their Teams pay an association fee which makes their fees close to ours - 15U and 19U has to be our fees - will be evaluating together - their registration closes next week - need to figure out evaluations before Friday - we have enough kids to make our own teams for most leagues - Strathmore fears they will lose their girls if they don't play tier 1
- We have red carpet they have Cheadle and kinsman diamond- email sent out stating we may be mixing teams - 18u possibly enough for 3 teams with Strathmore - 15u possibly 2 teams - if it doesn't work we won't do it next year
- Split the cost with Strathmore for evaluation field fees
- Can we guarantee a spot for a returning girl for U19

- Need evaluators - Strathmore sending evaluators but need to be on the same page for evaluation numbers
- Added the 24th date for evaluations
